FAST FACTS

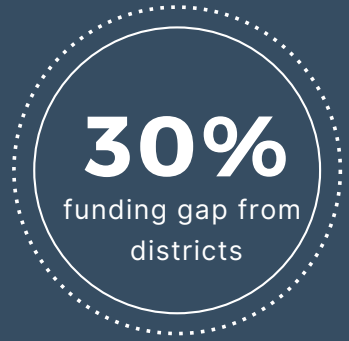
- In the 22-23 school year, Switzer provided over 3,800 hours of therapeutic support & 5,400 minutes of social skills training.

1. WASC ACCREDITATION
